## SCHOLARSHIP HISTORY

Mountain View Ruritan Club, Inc. established a Scholarship in 1981 for students of North Wilkes High School. An award has been made every year since except two, one was not accepted and the other not needed. The club has made permanent educational funds with The Ruritan National Foundation. One in memory of Rainer Wiles and the other is The Mountain View Ruritan Educational Fund. The Foundation uses the income from permanent funds to grant student scholarships and to make student loans. To establish permanent funds with the Ruritan National Foundation clubs must have at least on thousand dollars deposited in a fund.

## CLUB DOLLARS

The Ruritan National Foundation offers clubs a chance to provide \$ 300 dollars, select the recipient and get back a scholarship for their student in the amount of three hundred plus the interest on permanent funds divided equally among the clubs sending three hundred dollars which is a big help to cubs doing scholarships.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of Mountain View Ruritan's 500 dollar scholarship is to encourage deserving students of North Wilkes High School to further their education beyond high school.

## WHO MAY APPLY

Any North Wilkes High School Senior who can be accepted at a two or four year college or university may apply. An application may be obtained in the guidance office of North Wilkes High School and may be duplicated.

## CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Criteria for selecting the recipient include scholastic ability, financial need, character, and potential for success as determined by the student's record and the recommendations of counselors, teachers, ministers and/or employers. Parents need not be Ruritan members



## SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Committee of Mountain View Ruritan Club will carefully review each application. They will select a winner and a first runner-up, based on the preceding criteria. If the first-place winner cannot accept, the scholarship will go to the first runner-up

## AMOUNT OF GRANT

The Grant will be \$ 500 or more. Mountain View Ruritan awards the winner at least \$ 500 even if the club does not receive that much from The Ruritan National Foundation

## NATIONAL DEADLINE

All supporting documents must be on file with the educational foundation by the April 1 deadline. The scholarship committee will help the student they have selected, with this phase of the application using the ivory color form sent to the club secretary. This form cannot be duplicated and must be used to qualify for funds from the foundation.
